INTRODUCTION

Burkina Faso National Committee on Dams (BUCOD) is a non-profit scientific and technical association. BUCOD has among its objectives to:

- Promote progress in the design, construction, operation and management of dams and associated structures;
- Create a framework for scientific and technical exchanges for dam professionals;
- Create conditions conducive to the training and information of its members.

On December 6th to 8th, 2006, BUCOD held its first successful dam congress. In its 2018-2021 action plan, BUCOD has planned to organize annual conferences, the first of which will take place in September 2019.



CONFERENCE VENUE

The conference will take place in Ouagadougou, the capital city of Burkina Faso. It is a city of more than 2 million inhabitants that offers many opportunities for work, accommodation and recreational activities.

CALL FOR PAPER

The conference will be a forum for expression, sharing and mutual enrichment of water resources and dams professionals. Thus, it will take place on the theme "design and management of reservoirs" **with four sub-themes**

- *Estimation of water resources and sedimentation to a site,*
- *Sizing of dam reservoirs in the semi-arid context (yield analysis, maximum volumes, dead storage, etc.),*
- *Management of reservoirs and sedimentation,*
- *Flood management during operation of reservoirs.*

- August 31, 2019 : completed paper submission
